RULES TO CAMP BY...



It is the obvious that shirts must cover appropriately elbows and collar bones at all times.

Please make sure shirts are not too tight and are long enough so no skin is shown while playing sports.

Any form of large writing on the shirt, will not be permitted.



Girls are expected to wear knee socks at all times other than in the designated areas for water activities.

Socks should be long enough that no skin is shown between the sock and skirt. Girls will not be allowed to wear leggings even with long socks other than during dance or any exercise activities.



All skirts/dresses must cover the knees at ALL times.



Sneakers are the ideal choice of footwear for any camp activities.

Other shoes such as loafers are ok but they do not support or protect the foot like a sneaker.

For safety purposes, Natives, Floafers or any other footwear that does not provide sufficient support to the entire foot will not be permitted to be worn to any regular active camp activities.





We understand that some girls may prefer sleeping in pants and short sleeve shirts rather than a nightgown.

Girls that choose to do so, may ONLY take off their skirts and appropriate tops near their bed.

No walking around the bunkhouse and surely no leaving the bunkhouse without appropriate attire.

As a whole, we expect our staff members to dress, act and speak like respectable and refined Bnos Yisroel at all times. Remember, you are role models for our campers and with that comes the achrayus of setting a personal example for the young girls. We appreciate your cooperation in this matter.

GADGETS 'N STUFF &



As yidden, we are all aware of the dangers and high risks of exposing children to sensitive contents and technology in general. Out of concern for our campers' and staff wellbeing, belongings and general function of every bunk, the camp has adopted a policy of NO CELL PHONES OR ELECTRONIC GADGETS WITH PICTURE, VIDEO, AND WIFI CAPABILITY in camp. These include ALL SMART PHONES, PSP'S, IPODS, MP3S, GAMEBOYS, SMART WATCHES ETC. No exceptions. All staff members, INCLUDING girls returning from seminary will be allowed to bring flip phones to camp. The phones will be collected on the first day of camp. All staff members will be allowed to use their phones on Friday for an hour during Hachana Le'Shabbos. Details to follow.

In addition, basic digital cameras with no WiFi capability are allowed (such as Canon) with no previous pictures or videos on it.

As a camp we love and appreciate the value of clean Jewish music. Therefore, we will be providing each bunk speakers and access to fine music that we find is suitable for the ruach of camp.

If a staff member is found not in compliance of any of the above, camp reserves its right to enforce consequences.
